

Certificate IV Workplace Health & Safety

The Certificate IV in WHS aims to give participants the knowledge and skills to assist with managing WHS issues within the workplace including, identifying potential hazards, assessing and controlling risk and ensuring compliance.



Course Outline

This Workplace health and safety course has been designed for professionals seeking to either work in (or wanting to secure) a WH&S role, such as that of a WHS coordinator or safety advisor, or upskill within the workplace. Participants will learn how to identify workplace health and safety hazards, assess and control risks, ensure compliance with current legislation and consult on WHS issues.

Learning Outcomes

The Certificate IV in WHS covers the following;

- Implement and support workplace WHS management system.
- Prepare and advise workplace personnel for dealing with WHS issues.
- Understand WHS legislative requirements and assist with monitoring workplace compliance.
- Implement WHS initiatives and processes that support organisational WHS goals.
- Apply knowledge of risk assessment to contribute to the selection of risk-assessment techniques, tools and processes for hazards.
